NAME

mtable - creates a prom file for a table lookup multiplier

SYNOPSIS

mtable [-l] [-d] [help]

DESCRIPTION

mtable is a program useful for generating PROM files which implements a table lookup multiplier. It can also print-out debugging information which can be helpful in understanding the meaning of the table. The output is printed to the file, mtable.dat

OPTIONS

The command line options to mtable are :

-l # This sets the least significant bit (lsb) of the output byte and should range between 0 and 7, inclusive. The default is 7.

-d With no address, this causes debug information for every value in the table to be output(a BIG file). With an address, only the debug information for that address is output.

-help Print out a brief summary of the argument usage.
